- **Budget Summary from Crista Kuhn: \$121,000** currently in the bank. Katie Fogarty has checks coming in from Chipotle **\$502** and King Soopers **\$357**.

- Vote on teacher grant: 1 grade would like decodable books \$475.20

Details: Requested by Sylvia Doud, 1st grade teacher.

"I'd like to order a set of decodable books for small group reading. Based on the various reading levels in my class, I'd like to order the k/1 series, as well as the 2^{-1} grade series. Providing students with decodable readers during small group time will provide them with extra practice in developing their literacy skills. I'd like to set this system up as a "book club" to provide students with additional practice in discussing books beyond the CKLA curriculum. To do that I need books that are decodable at different reading levels, and a set of five so that each student may have their own book during the small group time."

Ron Salazar Update:

- \$113,100.00 is the number needed from PTSA (3 para's)
- Budget almost done. "Everything currently is still in the red but the carry over money from the saved SPED position will barely put us in green".
- Operation costs are down.
- Losing up to 3 staff positions.
 - o "Conversations on next steps are being had in the coming weeks with staff members".
- Shifting from a STL model to a learning specialist/ or team lead model will require a staffing adjustment.
 - o Currently leaning toward dropping 1 para
 - Going from 3 first grade classes to 2
 - Full time Para needed in kindergarten. 1/2/3 grade and 4/5 grade split for other 2 para positions
