Principal's Report

Ron Salazar Update

- Curriculum Night: There will still be time for teachers to share with parents/caregivers
 - Steck will be providing childcare in the gymnasium and library this year
- We have 11 fewer children at the start of this year, which corresponds to a 70K decrease in funding
 - There may be needed changes with staffing, but Mr. Salazar will provide updates as they become available
 - September 15th is the cutoff for enrollment count it is particularly important that students are in attendance that day
- Colorado Department of Education has placed Steck in the top 3 schools in the district, which is a jump from previous years' rankings
 - This reflects achievement and growth

- Mr. Salazar will be out of the building for some half days this year, Mr. Rios and other staff will be filling
 in as needed
- Volunteer meetings are occurring on a weekly basis (8:00am and 3:00pm on Mondays and Fridays. All
 volunteers (including room parents) are asked to attend one of these training so you can receive
 your Raptor screening and Steck ID badge.
