Budget

- Budget Summary (Crista Kuhn)
 - Current Balance/Standing: We have 153K currently in the account

Principal's Report

• Ron Salazar Update

- Budget has been finalized for next year and although the PTSA was able to provide some additional funds, cuts were still deemed necessary
 - Gifted and Talented has been maintained at .5 FTE, which will also allow for some support for students who need intervention in math
 - Math intervention has been eliminated; literacy intervention will be adjusted to .75 FTE
 - One paraprofessional position has been eliminated
 - This means staff will be called upon to assist with additional recess and lunch supervision
 - Library tech position has been eliminated; library staff position will be maintained but reduced to .5 FTE
 - Ron is expecting an eventual enrollment of between 295-298 but budget decisions needed to be made based on official projected enrollment rather than actual numbers next year
 - There will not be a third kindergarten classroom as this was not deemed a helpful solution to the challenges with attrition in older grade classrooms
 - Enrollment in 4th and 5th grade are expected to be between 20 and 21 students in each class
 - There are currently 5 students on the choice list for 5th grade, which is a change from the past
- Ron is asking for \$150,000 from the PTSA for the 24-25 school year

- The request for funding of \$150,000 would equate to roughly \$1000 donated per student
- Ron is hoping to budget in a way that allows for there to be some carryover into the 25-26 year
- Stacie put forth a motion to vote on the \$150,000 budget adjustment
 - Majority of attendees voted in favor of the increase
 - Katie will put together a communications update regarding the adjusted budget and general uses of the PTSA funds

Committee Reports

- Fundraising (Molly Babineaux): Steck Sustainer and Special Person's Day updates!
 - Special Friends Day is a go!
 - Date will be Wednesday, May 1st from 2:45 3:30pm. Teachers will be available during that time to greet students and their friends.
 - Molly will draft some flyers with details and a sign-up genius invitation
 - Volunteers would be greatly appreciated to assist with planning invitations and snacks as well as helping at the actual event
 - Steck Star Sustainer
 - We will send out a reminder regarding this funding option and hope to finish out the year strong
 - Staff may also receive Steck magnets to increase visibility
- Communications (Katie Neff): Katie will create an update regarding the adjusted budget and distribute that
- Annual Auction (Katie Fogarty): No updates
- Room Parents (Ramona Harris):
 - Individual classrooms are working on their Valentine's Day events
 - Ramona is working on setting up a Parent's Day Out as an opportunity for families to meet each other in a social setting
- Teacher/Staff Appreciation (Stacie Loucks):
 - Teacher appreciation week is May 6th-10th
 - Plans for this week are in progress
 - This committee is making attempts to reduce overall spending in order to leave additional funds for other PTSA needs
- Garden Club/Beautification Committee (Stacie Loucks):
 - The committee raised enough money from the garden sales last year to be able to pay for some maintenance items
 - There will likely be another event in the Spring
 - The goal for this committee is to try and be self-sustaining

Additional Items

- Recess volunteers are always appreciated sign-up link is on ClassTag (Recess Volunteers)
 - Because of staff reductions Ron is routinely spending time on lunch duty. Any volunteers will free him up for his specific principal responsibilities.
- Almost all of our current PTSA board members are at the end of their 2-year terms.
 - Please reach out to parents in current positions with any questions
 - If more than 1 person expresses interest in a board position, there will be an official vote at the last meeting in May.
